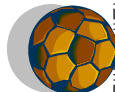
Dave Howells will be running sessions for all KS2 boys (year3—6) and girls in year 5 & 6. Session dates will be printed in next weeks Muxton Matters.

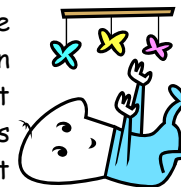
More News
