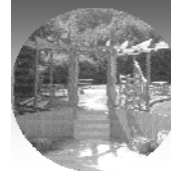

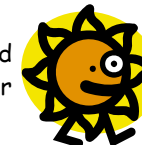

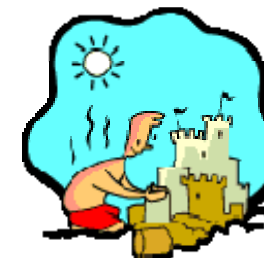

Good luck to all our Y6 pupils who will be moving on. We wish you happiness in all that you do and achieve.

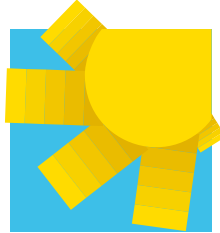

### Water Aid

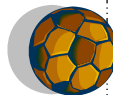
