Dear Parent/Carer,

We have only been back two weeks and it's time for our year 6 children to think about the school of their choice for next September. These children will come home today with an envelope which has a letter to parents from Telford and Wrekin admissions, a booklet, and a simple guide to admissions procedures leaflet and also details about the Family Information Service.

Please bear in mind that Open Days start as early as next week. There is an Open Evening for all Years at Wrekin College on Tuesday 22nd September and an Open Morning on Wednesday 23rd. Newport Girls High School have their Open day on the 1st October. The school will be open from 9.30am until 12.00 noon and then a twilight session from 4.00pm to 7.00pm. There is a full list of dates and times of all schools open events on page 20 of the booklet and on the simple guide sheet. The date listed for preference forms to be returned to school is the 31st October. However we will still accept forms on our first day back after half term on the 3rd November.

If you wish your daughter to be considered for a place at Newport High School you should include this on the preference form. Newport Girls High School tests will be taken on the 12th December at Harper Adams University College.

If you would like Adams Grammar as your first choice you should include this on the preference form and also contact Adams Grammar for a supplementary information form. You can make your application online if you wish at [www.telford.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.telford.gov.uk/admissions). Telford and Wrekin are advising that 4 choices should be given on the form. Letters will be sent to parents by first class post informing them of their child's allocation on the **1st March 2010**.

### Message from the 'Friends'

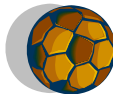
