Poppy Richards gained a Bronze Award in Ice Skating.

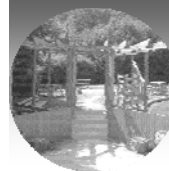
Sam Briggs has achieved his Tadpole 3, and 10 metre swimming certificate.

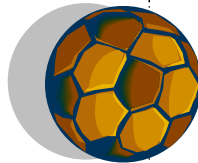
### Rounders/Cricket
