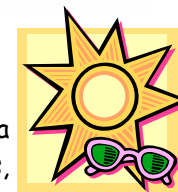

### Telford and Wrekin Music

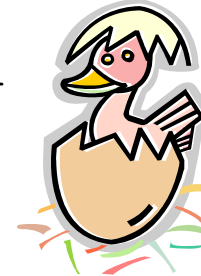
