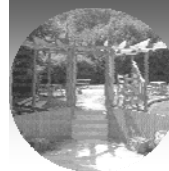

There will be no more Cross Country for the rest of this term.

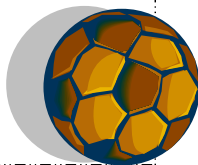
KS1 Choir—Apologies for late cancellation this week.
