- \* Measures we can take to reduce any transmission are, washing of hands, coughing and sneezing into tissue and disposal of them.

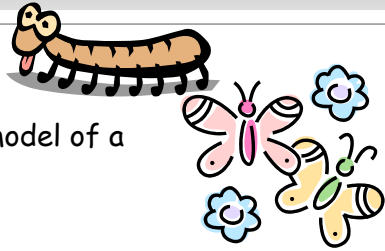
